

he period July to September 2019 has witnessed significant strides in the operations of the University Library especially in terms of its services delivery, information resources acquisition drive, provision of furniture and other equipment, visitations by individuals and organizations, and capacity building for staff.

Of note in this regard is the support of the Vice Chancellor, Professor Muhammad Yahuza Bello and his Management Team, for renewal of subscription to Law Companion and Springer Databases, servicing of some equipment including air conditioning units in the Faculty of Education Library, partitioning of the same library to provide office accommodation for the Liaison Librarian. Others include replacement of networking Radio and Power Over Ethernet (POE) at the Science Library, acquisition of books and journals, replacement of main water booster at the Main Library, provision of furniture, servicing the computers at the Medical College Library, repairs of serviceable reading chairs and tables in the Main and Branch libraries as well as

conferences/workshops attendance by library staff.

A milestone development is the preparation and submission of proposal for TETFund library development intervention (merged for the years 2014/2015/2016/2017) by the University Library, graciously facilitated by the Vice Chancellor. With this development the University Library stands to record significant boost in its operations and services delivery in support of teaching/learning and research in the University.

During the quarter, the trend of donations of information resources and visitations by scholars and other friends of the Library was beautifully recorded by the University Library. In this vein, the active use of newly furnished Postgraduate Carrels has formerly commenced in the Main Library.

Motivation for staff of the University Library has received boost from the University Management as many of them have been promoted by the Appointments and Promotions Committee of the University during the 2019 promotion exercise.

On equally pleasant note, the Special Needs Persons Section of the Main Library, which has been fully equipped and furnished by the University Management is ready for use and will soon be commissioned by the Vice Chancellor.
