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## From the Desk of the University Librarian



The quarter July 2018 to September 2018 has witnessed notable library-related developments which have positively impacted on the University Library in terms of patronage, services delivery, capacity building for staff and support by the Vice-Chancellor and his Management team. Eminent visitors to the University Library during the quarter included a publicity team from the Federal College of Education Kano Library; the Local Organizing committee (L.O.C) of the 2018 International Science Conference of the University (BUKISC 2018) comprising its Chairman, Deans and other members; Director Public Affairs of the Vice-Chancellor's office; as well as Dr. Hannah Hochner of the Centre for Migration and International Studies, University of Antwerp, Belgium accompanied by Dr. Musa Ibrahim and Dr. Kabiru Haruna Isa of the History Department of Bayero University, Kano.

The Vice Chancellor Prof. Muhammad Yahuza Bello, as usual, has made a number of approvals for Library service Facilities during the quarter, especially for the Muhammad Ata Al-Sid Law Library, which has upgraded the services delivery profile of that Library, including its e-services.

The University Library has equally witnessed inflows of information resources in forms of donations from friendly individuals, which has boosted its collection strength.

On a more pleasant note, efforts toward establishing a cooperative society for staff of the University Library has come to fruition with the formal registration of Bayero University Library Multi-purpose

Cooperative Society (BULMCOPS) on 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2018 and the formal visit by a team of officials from the Kano State Ministry of Commerce and Industry that witnessed the formal opening of the Secretariat of the Society in the Main Library.

This edition **BUKLibriUpdate** is special in a way, as it features **Photo Gallery of Open Space Reading Facilities** provided by the University Management in the three Major Campuses of the University. The facilities have attracted patronage by students who are obviously delighted by their provisions as alternative reading conveniences to conventional libraries and reading rooms.

Capacity building for staff of the University Library has received boost from the University Management as many of them have been promoted, some have attended conferences, and some have received approvals for attending more conferences. During the quarter, in a similar vein, staff of the University Library have made pre-conferences and post conferences paper presentations for knowledge and experience sharing.

Promoting the use of the library by students and staff is an issue of concern to the University Library Management. This is because the quantum of financial and other resources expended for the development of the University Library and its services delivery call for effective patronage, which otherwise will translate into waste. An excellent innovation and a model approach to promoting effective patronage of the services of the University Library by students was introduced in August by Prof. Abdullahi Sule-Kano of the Department of Political Science, who incidentally is the Chairman, Friends of the Library Association of the University and former National President of the Academic Staff Union of the Universities (ASUU). The model, developed by the eminent scholar has proved effective, which we advocate for all academics in the University as highlighted in details inside this issue of BUKLibriUpdate.

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In order to ensure wider publicity of our resources, services and other activities, the Department of Automation, Multi-Media and E-Services has upgraded the library website in September, which could be accessed through the following address: [www.library.buk.edu.ng](http://www.library.buk.edu.ng). We urge members of the University community and the wider society to endeavor to pay regular visits to the site. Similarly, this edition has featured information on existing online and offline databases domiciled with the University Library in order to facilitate access to our e-resources and services.

On a note of conclusion, the preceding narration clearly point to pleasant experience to be encountered by reading this edition of BUKlibriUpdate and for which all are welcomed.

### Vice Chancellor Approves Services Facilities for Muhammad Ata Al-Sid Law Library

In accordance with his commitment to supporting the University Library at all times, the Vice Chancellor Prof. Yahuza Bello has approved the subscription of complete 2018 set of Weekly Law Report, for the Muhammed Ata Al-sid Law Library which is considered the richest legal information conveyer in Nigeria. The V.C has similarly approved the upgrade subscription of E-version of Law companion for 2018 which has already been put to effective patronage by users of that Library; and the acquisition of Moyer's Classification Scheme, which is an important tool for classifying information resources in the discipline of Law. In addition the V.C has approved the branding of furniture and equipment including computers acquired for the University Library through 2011/12/13 Tetfund Library Intervention; as well as 1no. Braille machine and 1no. Scanner for use in the University Library. The University Library expresses deep appreciation for the consistent support of the V.C and his Management team.

### Central Library Development Committee Meets

The Central Library Development Committee chaired by the Deputy Vice Chancellor (Academics) Prof. Sagir Adamu Abbas had its 2nd meeting on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2018. The following were among the major decisions and resolutions of the meeting:

1. Reiterating mandatory deposition of all publications by academic departments and other units to the University Library (at least 2 copies).
2. Need for collaborative effort between the Directorate of Research, Innovation and Partnerships (DRIP), the Centre for Information Technology (CIT), the Directorate of Academic Planning (DAP) and the University Press, in developing anti-plagiarism software.
3. The Committee reaffirms the need for the provision of functional computer systems and independent internet services for the University Library and its respective branches, as was suggested by some professional bodies during accreditations exercises.
4. Need for electronics resources policy for the University.
5. The committee also encouraged continues establishment of Library Corners for individuals who donate high quality books and journals to the University Library, similar to Prof. Umar A. Pate Corner in the Reserve section of the Main Library, and the Prof. Sadiq Isa Radda Corner at the Social and Management Science Library.

### University Library Receives Donations of Information Resources

During the period July to September 2018 the University Library has received donation of books & and journals (hard) from individual friends of the Library that are rich in content and variety of subjects. Notable among the donors are:-

1. Dr. Salisu Adamu Alero, the University Librarian of Kebbi State University and alumni of BUK, who donated 12 Titles and 17 Volumes of books, One PhD thesis as well as 5 copies of news magazines.

The title of the book is *Media Reflections on Government and Development in Nigeria*.
4. Prof. Isa Hashim (Jarman Kano) donated a book of essays titled *Dala Hill: Selected Papers on Some Issues in Administrative Reforms in Nigeria* (2<sup>nd</sup> edition). From all indications, the variety of issues analyzed in the essays are topical and the period covered, which amounts to decades makes it a compulsive reading for scholars and researcher in public administration, finance, politics and developmental studies.
3. Prof. Haruna Wakili, the Director Mambayya House and newly appointed Deputy Vice Chancellor (Administration) of the University who donated a
